ROCKLAND — The following cases were closed in Sixth District Court from Jan. 19 to Jan. 23.

Valerie A. Dimattia, 23, of Thomaston was found guilty of domestic violence assault and was fined \$300 and sentenced to seven days in jail.

Yancey M. Harvey Sr., 36, of Waldoboro was found guilty of loaded firearm or crossbow in a motor vehicle and was fined \$200.

George Kibitz, 69, of Spruce Head was found guilty of hunting from stand or blind overlooking deer bait and was fined \$200.

Christopher Lowell, 40, of Rockland was found guilty of violating protective order and violating condition of release and was sentenced to 48 hours in jail.

Michael S. Nelson, 23, of Warren was found guilty of operating while license suspended or revoked, operating after registration suspended, and attaching false plates and was fined a total of \$500.

Kendall J. Ross, 24, of Rockland had charges of unlawful possession of scheduled drug and unlawful use of license dismissed.

Justin A. Steeves, 22, of Rockland was found guilty of assault and was fined \$300 and sentenced to seven days in jail.

Dustin B. Stimpson, 24, of Union was found guilty of violating condition of release and was sentenced to five days in jail.

Jonathan Whiffen, 47, of Rockland had a criminal mischief charge dismissed.

Larry W. Winchenbach, 26, of St. George was found guilty of domestic assault and was fined \$300 and sentenced to 180 days in jail with all but 30 days suspended and was required to serve one year of probation. He also was found guilty of criminal mischief and obstructing report of a crime and was sentenced to seven days in jail.

John J. Wood, 20, of Warren was found guilty of hunting with firearms or a crossbow without hunter orange and was fined \$100.

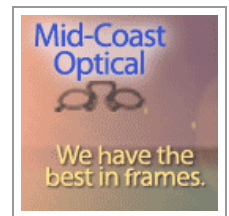
