ROCKLAND — The Rockland Police Department reported the following activity from Jan. 19 to Jan. 23.

In a report dated Jan. 14 and published in The Herald Gazette on Jan. 22, an accident was reported as involving Jarod Sullivan, 25, and Christine Hupper, 35, both of Thomaston. In the final accident report, the names were listed as Jarod Standing and Christine Hupper.

Jan. 20

Heather E. Roman, 21, of Waldoboro was driving a 1997 Dodge sedan. John E. Martin, 38, of Warren was driving a 2001 Ford pickup truck. According to the police report, Roman was traveling south on Route 1 at Birch Street, and Martin was traveling west on North Main Street. A witness driving behind Roman's car said she thought Roman had a red light. According to Rockland Police Sgt. Jeff McLaughlin, who responded to the accident, Rockland Fire Department and Emergency Medical Services personnel responded to the call and transported Roman, who is five months pregnant, to Penobscot Bay Medical Center in Rockport for evaluation and possible treatment. Martin complained of knee pain but refused treatment. Damage to the vehicles was estimated at \$8,000 each.

Tiffany B. Andrews, 73, of Camden was driving a 2000 Subaru station wagon. James W. Myrick, 33, of Warren was driving a 1999 International Harvester/Navistar truck. According to the police report, Andrews was attempting to merge onto Park Street from the Laundromat parking lot. A person in a vehicle traveling west stopped in traffic and motioned for her to proceed from the parking lot. The report said Andrews assumed that Myrick would also stop behind the stopped vehicle and proceeded to make a left turn onto Park Street. Myrick continued in the left lane and his vehicle was struck in the side by Andrews' vehicle. Damage to the vehicles was estimated at \$4,500 and \$1,000, respectively.

Richard Austin, 31, of Waldoboro was summoned for operating with a child not secured in a child seat and was fined \$70.
